With our software, you will be able to:

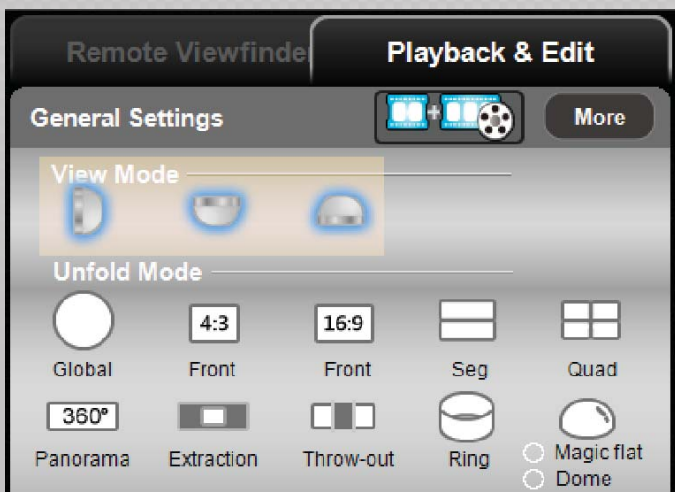
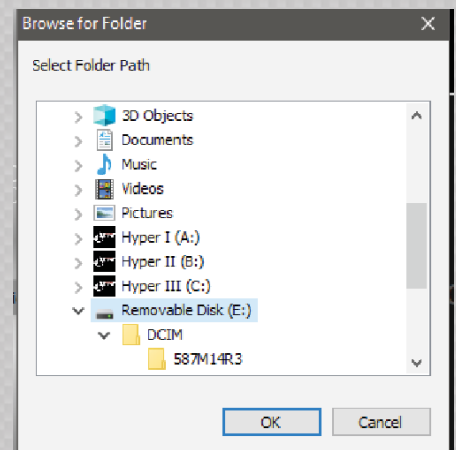
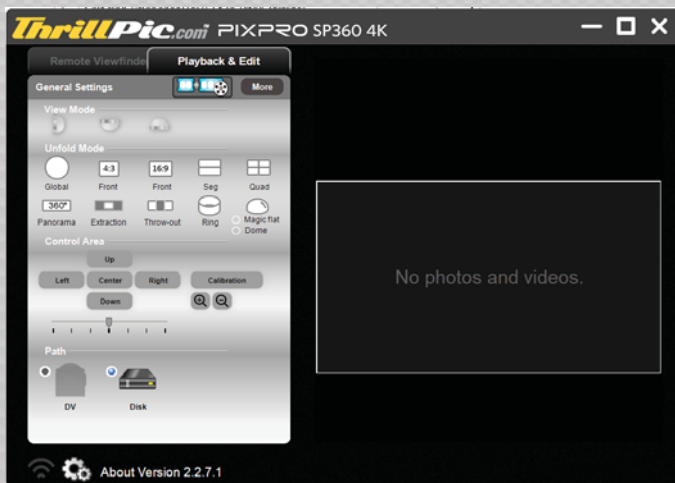
- View the 360 in car video
- Quickly edit and record your video to standard MP4 format
- Upload your video to Youtube and Facebook
- Play your experience on a TV or other devices

Installing the software

- Insert your SD Card into your PC or Mac
- Select the PixPro Software folder and install the app that matches your device
- Follow the on screen instructions until setup completes

Viewing your 360 footage

- Load the software and double click on the "Disk" option located bottom left of the screen.
- Use your explorer window to find your video. This is usually;
SD Card > DCIM > 123M4R5
(this last folder will be different for every person)

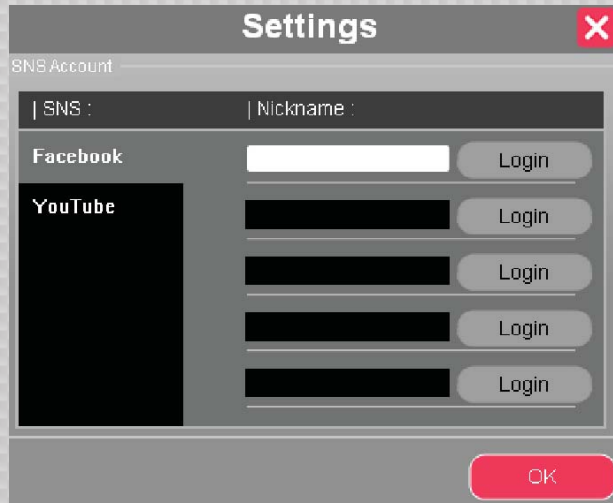


- Click "OK" and press the Play button on the bottom right of the page

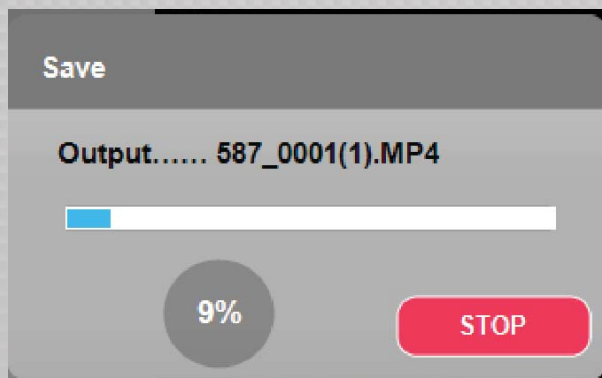
- If your video happens to be upside down, use the "View Mode" options on the left to rotate the video.

Share your footage on Social Media

- Click the "Share" button
- Click on "SNS Account" and enter your Youtube or Facebook credentials in the correct sections
- Simply follow the on screen instructions to proceed



View your experience on your TV



- Load the video onto your PC/Mac, and press "Record" on the software
- Choose a location to save the MP4
- Your video will now begin to record
- You can move the video around using your mouse while in record mode. Your movements will be recorded in real time onto the MP4 file.

- Once finished simply click the STOP button
- Wait for the software to save the finished video file and click "Finish" once complete.

- You can view your MP4 using Windows Media Player or VLC (or any equivalent)
- Alternatively you save this video file on any media (USB, CD, DVD)
